

### *Who pays the surcharge?*

The Community Preservation Surcharge (sometimes referred to as C.P.F. or C.P.A.) is paid by residential property owners.

### *How does the surcharge calculation work?*

Please refer to the following sample calculation.

**\*\*Our C.P.F. Surcharge example depicts a moderate Residential Assessment at the 2025 Residential Tax Rate**

**Assessed Value	\$801,629
**FY25 Tax Rate	\$14.64
FY25 Tax	\$11,735.85
C.P.A Residential Exemption (\$100,000 off valuation)	\$801,629 less \$100,000
C.P.A Taxable Value	\$701,629
C.P.A Tax Basis	\$10,271.85
C.P.A. Surcharge	3.0% \$308.15

\*CPF changes every year as the tax rate adjusts  
(assessed value-\$100k x tax rate x .030)

## *Are there exemptions to the Surcharge?*

- The first \$100,000 of taxable residential value is exempt from the Surcharge calculation.
- Any residential property entitled to abatement or statutory exemption is automatically entitled to a proportional C.P.F. exemption.

### *What are the requirements for full C.P.F. Exemption?*

To qualify for this exemption for fiscal **year 2026** you must meet certain income requirements based on **2024 income**. An application must be completed and filed with the Assessors Office.

- Age and residence requirements must be met as of **January 1, 2025**.
- **Over 60 years** of age with annual income not exceeding the following for your size household:

### ***What is CPF?***

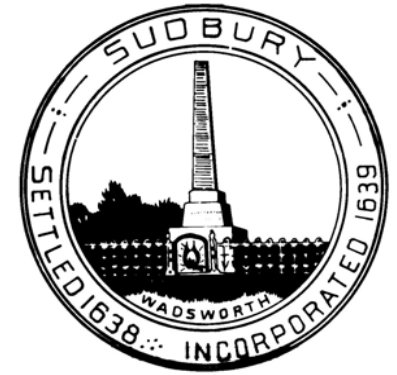
The Community Preservation Act which was adopted by Sudbury voters in March of 2002 established a funding source financed by surcharge revenues, and the Commonwealth of Mass. (with matching funds), for the purpose of open space, historical preservation and community housing projects and purchases.

### ***Applications***

An application for exemption from the C.P.F. Surcharge based on income must be filed timely with the Board of Assessors.
