Request for Extension of Special Permit – Case 04-45

Constance Far and Mark Sevier were present to request an extension of their Special Permit to allow demolition of an existing residence and construction of a new residence on a nonconforming lot at 14 Arborwood Road.

Mr. Sevier referenced his letter dated August 30, 2005 which indicates that due to unforeseen circumstances, a death in the family and a medical issue, that they are unable to start construction this fall as planned. They are requesting a 6-month extension and plan construction in the spring.

The Board had no problem with this request. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously voted to extend Special Permit 04-45 for a period of six months, said permit to expire on May 9, 2006 if construction has not begun.

Vote on Bond Closeout – Brunjes d/b/a Hitchcock – ERB 96-2

The Board was in receipt of a letter dated September 12, 2005 from Town Engineer which notes that after review of the as-built plan, it was found that the site has been constructed in general conformance with the approved plan. Town Engineer recommends the bond be released to Brunjes, Inc.

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously voted to release the bond in the amount of \$12,150 and to authorize the Treasurer to forward that bond to Brunjes, Inc.
