## MEETING OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS

## Zoning Board of Appeals and Earth Removal Board Annual Meeting:

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

The Board was in receipt of the February 2011 Rules and Regulations, Supplemental Rules for Comprehensive Permits, and the Rules and Regulations for the Earth Removal Board. The only change to be made to the ZBA Rules and Regulations was to update any references to the "Chairman" to instead say the "Chair." A motion was made to adopt the documents as revised and it was unanimously approved.

A motion was also made and voted unanimously to continue Elizabeth Quirk's term as Chair until February, 2013, the next Annual Meeting. This language shall be added to the Board's standard conditions for Accessory Dwellings as it currently is listed on decisions for teardowns and reconstructions.
