Flu Clinics:

- There was a good turnout for the Board of Health sponsored flu clinics
- DPH supplied 2300 doses of which 800 were distributed- both mist and injectable

Trash Hauler Fees:

- Regulations were passed in 2000 but never enacted
- Basic \$100.00 fee per business
- Waste Management Companies include:

 - (d) Mister Trash Man
 - (e) Waste Management
- The Board of Health would be responsible for setting up the rules/regulations/permitting fees
- The Board will finalize fee schedule at the next Board meeting on Monday December 13th

Budget Package:

- The 2012 Budget Package will be presented by December 10th
- The Health Director will meet with the Town Manager to discuss budget on December 14th
- The Board of Health has received a donation for the Cavanaugh fund in the amount of \$3000.00- these funds will override the Mental Health line item for the Board of Health 2012 budget
- The Health Director will propose a preliminary budget for the Board's review

Miscellaneous Business:

- Beaver activity is still high at the Pantry Brook Dam location
- A beaver trapper will be working with the Board of Health during the first two weeks of December to help trap beavers
