Consideration of application for transfer of the Restaurant License for the Sale of All Alcoholic Beverages, under General Laws Ch. 138, sec. 12, from Philip Magiannis, Owner, d/b/a Philip's Pizza, to Philip's Pizza & Restaurant, Inc., Philip Magiannis, Manager, d/b/a Philip's Pizza & Restaurant Inc., for property at 447 Boston Post Road.

Consideration of application of Country Variety & Deli, Inc., Gary J. Volante, Manager, for a Package Goods Store License to Sell Wines and Malt Beverages, under General Laws Chapter 138, sec. 15, at property located at 621C Boston Post Road.

At 8:00 p.m. Chairman Cope convened the 210th Session of the Town Forum.

Following reports by the various Boards and Departments, Town Forum was adjourned, and refreshments and conversation were enjoyed by those present. This Town Forum was televised over the local Cable network and a copy of the video tape is available by contacting the Selectmen's office.
