

IN BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
MONDAY, APRIL 1, 1996

Present: Chairman John C. Drobinski, Selectmen Lawrence L. Blacker and Maryann K. Clark.

The statutory requirements as to notice having been met, the meeting was convened by Chairman Drobinski at 7:15 p.m. in the library of the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School.

Town Meeting

Article 3 - Stabilization Fund

Following discussion, it was agreed to utilize Article 3, if necessary, to indirectly fund Articles 24 - Codify Bylaw (\$6,000) and 25 - History Sequel (\$4,000), leaving a balance of \$67,219 for the school operating budget for FY1996 under Article 4, to be funded from FY96 excess Cherry Sheet receipts, which had previously been reserved for appropriation.

Articles 7 & 8 - Attached Single Family Housing for Persons Over 55

Selectman Clark expressed concern over these articles. Chairman Drobinski stated the vote was currently at 2-1 in support. It was decided that Selectman Blacker would speak in favor and Selectman Clark would speak against.

Article 19 - Personnel Administration Plan Bylaw

Selectman Clark expressed the desire to indefinitely postpone the article as there has been no discussion with the Town Manager relative to same. Town Manager indicated that upon deletion of the Personnel Bylaw by vote of Town Meeting, he would immediately adopt the deleted Personnel Bylaw which would allay Ms. Clark's concerns. At Chairman Drobinski's suggestion, discussion of this consent calendar article was tabled until the following evening.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned to the High School Auditorium to attend and participate in Town Meeting until its close.
