Present: Chairman Lawrence L. Blacker and Selectmen John C. Drobinski, and Maryann K. Clark.

The statutory requirements as to notice having been complied with, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Blacker at 7:05 p.m. in the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School Library.

Ballot Questions for May Special Town Election

A problem with the wording of Ballot Question No. 2, as proposed by Selectman Clark, had been discovered, and Selectman Clark provided the Board with corrected wording. The Board agreed to the same subject to Town Counsel's review.

As a result of the Weisblatt Unique Acquisition Advertisement being confirmed for publication on April 22 in the Central Register, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To rescind the Board's vote of April 13, 1998, with regarding to calling a Special Town Election to be held May 18, 1998, and approving questions therefor; and, further

VOTED: To call a Special Town Election to be held on Wednesday, May 27, 1998, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at the Noyes School and Fairbank Community Center; and, further

VOTED: To place the two questions concerning 1) School Department override, and 2) Weisblatt Property Acquisition on the ballot, the wording subject to approval by Town Counsel.

Following review by Town Counsel, the finalized questions were approved as follows:

QUESTION NO. 1

Shall the Town of Sudbury be allowed to assess an additional \$592,250 in real estate and personal property taxes for the purpose of an override to provide additional funds for the Sudbury Public Schools operating budget and School-related Unclassified Employee Benefits accounts for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1998?

QUESTION NO. 2

Shall the Town of Sudbury be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, as a debt exclusion, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to acquire in fee simple a portion of the land known as the Weisblatt Property consisting of approximately 41.3 acres located on the northeast slope of Nobscot Mountain, off Adams Road and 641 Boston Post Road, shown as Lot #2 on "Plan of Land in Sudbury, Mass. Owner: A. Weisblatt Realty Trust", dated January 27, 1998, drawn by Schofield Brothers of New England, Inc., as amended by "Sketch Plan of Weisblatt Land", dated April 6, 1998, on file in the Town Clerk's Office?
