Collective Bargaining with Engineer Union

Town Manager Maureen Valente presented the Board with the agreed upon Memorandum of Agreement between the Town of Sudbury and the Association of Engineers, Architects and Draftsmen Local #105. She noted the union has ratified and signed the MOA. She further noted it adhered to all the financial guidelines set forth by the Selectmen. The Board members indicated their agreement with the terms of the MOA, Selectman Drobinski moved to approve, and Selectman Haarde seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous for approval.

Potential Sale of Town's Interest in Wayland-Sudbury Septage Facility

Town Manager Maureen Valente reviewed an offer to purchase Sudbury's interest in the Septage Facility received from Wayland. She noted that for the most part Wayland had incorporated the requirements the Board had established previously into their offer, with a few exceptions noted by Town Counsel and herself. Board directed Town Manager to incorporate those items into the existing document and bring back a red-line version for their final approval at their next meeting on Feb 19, 2013.
