MONDAY, MARCH 30, 1998

Present: Chairman Lawrence L. Blacker and Maryann K. Clark.

The statutory requirements for notice having been complied with, Chairman Blacker called to order an emergency meeting on March 30, 1998, at 8:00 a.m. in the Loring Parsonage, 288 Old Sudbury Road.

Special Town Meeting Called - April 15, 1998

The Board of Selectmen had been informed by State Representative Susan Pope that the General Court would not accept the Town's recently filed Special Act on the matter of the Wilcox Conservation Restriction relocation, because the Town Meeting vote authorizing this legislation was not current, but taken in 1995. It thus required a new vote of the Town Meeting, or in the alternative, the Governor might file the petition on behalf of the Town.

Not having received an affirmative answer on whether the Governor would file Sudbury's petition, in the interest of time, this being the only window for calling a special town meeting within the annual town meeting, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To call an Emergency Special Town Meeting to be held on Wednesday, April 15, 1998, at 7:30 p.m. at the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School; and further

VOTED: To submit therefor a repeat of Article 43 of the 1995 Annual Town Meeting for confirmation by the voters; and further

VOTED: To close the Warrant for said Special Town Meeting immediately; and further

VOTED: To sign the Warrant for the April 15, 1998 Emergency Special Town Meeting, as presented.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:10 a.m.
