

# **Department Feedback**

Department	Staff	Approve/Deny	Comments
Building Department	Mark Herweck	Approved	The previous occupancy was 55 on the first floor and 55 on the second floor for a total of 110. To increase the occupant load they need an Architect or Professional Engineer to wet stamp a set of floor plans showing new seating with occupant load posted. They need to show accessibility seating compliant with the AAB. They will need a building permit with construction control for the proposed changes. I also need the Board of Health's approval for the increased load to the septic system prior to a permit being issued. I have lighting complaints from the abutters about the glare from the rear parking lot lights that have been relocated on the building. I am also receiving complaints about holiday lighting from the neighboring buildings at 29 Hudson.
Fire Department	Chief Whalen	Approved	The Fire Department has no issues with this application. A complete fire and safety inspections will be conducted prior to opening.
Health Department	Bill Murphy	Approved	The Health Dept. does not have issues with this application. I have asked the applicant to produce information from the management company regarding the ability of septic system to support a 200 seat restaurant including bar and outdoor seating. I have not received this to date. We will not issue a food permit until this issue is resolved.
Police Department	Chief Nix	Approved	The Police Department does not have any issues with the application.

**Town Counsel** (Brian Riley) reviewed the application on 2/13/19. He provided clarification on the listing of investors and found no issues.

# Response from Applicant regarding above feedback:

This is all fine, my architect will have a wet stamp on the plans this week. We are just finalizing everything to be sure it is perfect.

The existing drawings we received from the town did not match how the restaurant was built so we lost some time redoing the "existing conditions" before we could add our betterments to it.

I will be reaching out to Bill and Mark this week with final plans and seating counts.



# **Board of Selectmen Ballot Question Policy**

Chapter 180 of the Acts of 1996 requires the Sudbury Board of Selectmen to provide registered voters the following information for any ballot question submitted solely to Town voters (other than a ballot pursuant to M.G.L. ch.53, §18A): (1) the full text of such question; (2) a fair and concise summary of such question; and (3) arguments for and against such question. See Attachment.

Further requirements include the following:

- The required information is to be sent to the voters at least 7 days before such an election.
- The Board of Selectmen, or when designated, Town Counsel, shall seek written arguments from the principal proponents and opponents of each question.
- The Board of Selectmen shall designate a date for receipt for such arguments and shall provide notice of such 14 days before the date arguments are to be received.
- The Board of Selectmen shall determine those best able to present the arguments for and against each question.
- If no argument is received within the time allowed, Town Counsel shall prepare such argument.
- No argument shall contain more than 250 words.

The requirements of this law will be implemented as follows for any ballot questions to be submitted for an Annual Town Election or a Special Town Election.

- Notice of proposed ballot questions and a request for written arguments for and against the
  questions will be posted on the Town website at least or <u>46 days</u> before the election plus
  additional days as needed to allow Board of Selectmen meetings for actions listed below.
  The Board of Selectmen will also reach out to relevant parties including petitioners for
  citizen questions and ballot question committees.
- The Board of Selectmen will determine those persons best able to present the arguments for and against each question in an open meeting. In the absence of submission, Town Counsel will prepare the argument.
- Written arguments for and against ballot questions will be reviewed by Town Counsel for legal compliance. Neither Town Counsel nor the Board of Selectmen will review or edit the written arguments for substance, opinion, or accuracy.

Selectman Carty stated that it would be helpful to know the financial significance.

Town Manager Rodrigues stated that it's the same cost of running the parsonage; we pay for insurance, snow removal and sharing of other expenses. She added that this has been the arrangement for almost a year.

Selectman Brown offered that it might be useful to see if other communities have done a similar project.

### **Discuss ATM Warrant Articles**

At 8:54 p.m., Town Manager Rodrigues shared with the Board that the following itemized articles were outlined for discussion and have been submitted: hear reports, stabilization fund, fund litigation – Sudbury Station, Fund litigation – Eversource, FY18 budget adjustments, Fairbank, Loring Parsonage Lease, October Town Meeting.

Chairman Haarde said that the article authorizing the Board of Selectmen to convey the Melone property should be put on as a placeholder as well.

Selectman Iuliano said there is no decision about selling property and would we want a placeholder?

Vice-Chairman Simon said it's four months before Town Meeting, and he feels that the Melone property should not consider a placeholder due to more important issues at this time. He reviewed the land at the former Police station site on Route 20 several years ago, and continued that there was no in-depth study of what the Town might do with this land. He added that residents must be involved in the possible selling of the Melone land, and that he strongly feels that this area should not be taken up for further action at this time.

Selectman Iuliano said that she was fine with a placeholder and that the Board could discuss it between now and May. Selectman Iuliano stated that both Chairman Haarde and Vice-Chairman Simon were right, and that tonight the vote was just for an option.

Vice-Chairman Simon stated that in the past, this has not been a transparent area, and further maintained that the Board does not have the final GeoInsight report yet.

Chairman Haarde disagreed and said the discussions have been robust and transparent; discussed many times, and that all discussions have been open to the public.

Resident Janie Dretler, 286 Goodman's Hill Road, told the Board that she attended the Melone Charrette which highlighted housing, commercial revenue and possible recreation at the Melone site. She continued by stating that since the Charrette, an RFP for ball fields had been done. She said that she wants to know what the process should be and wants to understand the environmental aspect.

Chairman Haarde said that he is unsure if passive recreation is the favored choice for the site. There is a need for organized recreation, and there is a likelihood that commercial, housing and recreation could co-exist here. Selectman Iuliano reinforced that all ideas should be considered.

Ms. Dretler <u>suggested</u> that the Town look at all three options: housing, commercial revenue, and recreation (passive and active). Said that she would prefer to see housing at the site, but agreed that all three uses should be explored further heard that we need more fields, however, she doesn't know if it's necessary since she doesn't have that data. It would be good to look at least at all three pieces and then make a decision once she has more information. Chairman Haarde added that more information will be forthcoming.
