Appointment - Special Police Officers

Coffee Hut Kiosk

The Board received Town Counsel's opinion, dated July 11, 1990, which concurred with the Building Inspector's opinion that the Sudbury Farms former Fotomat kiosk may be used as a proposed "coffee hut" business.
