

IN BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Present: Chairman Judith A. Cope, David A. Wallace and John C. Drobinski.

The statutory requirement as to notice having been fulfilled, Chairman Cope called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Library at the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School.

Walker/Walsh Yard Sale - Request For Placement of Sign

The Board considered request of Art Walker to place a sign for the Walker/Walsh Yard Sale, to be held this weekend at Curtis Middle School, on the Town Common.

It was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To deny request of Art Walker to place a sign for the Walker/Walsh Yard Sale to be held at Curtis Middle School on the Town Common.

The Selectmen requested Executive Secretary Thompson to explain to Mr. Walker that it is the Board's policy not to allow signs on Town Common for anything but Town business; and they suggested contacting the Police Station as a possible site for placement.

Unisys

The Board acknowledged receipt of letter dated April 2, 1991, from Thomas R. Severino, Corporate Director, Environmental Affairs, Unisys Corporation, relative to current site environmental investigations.

Executive Secretary Thompson reported that he has been monitoring the situation and is assured that Unisys intends to live up to their commitment.

Town Meeting

Present: Ralph Tyler, Coldbrook Development.

Ralph Tyler of Coldbrook Development, stated his belief that perhaps there has not been enough attention given to the rezoning articles relating to the Unisys property. Mr. Tyler explained that these petition articles were prepared because he wanted to put something on the table to bring the Town and Unisys together, since it is his opinion that the two entities are far apart on the purchase and sale issue.

Executive Secretary Thompson stated his concern is that whether the articles pass or fail, the Town is between a rock and a hard place. Mr. Thompson went on to say that he believes it is legally dangerous for the Selectmen to get too vocal on the issue and it is his suggestion that they do not speak on these articles. Mr. Tyler conceded that the Selectmen should take whatever position they want.

At the request of Mr. Tyler, the Selectmen will announce another Open House on the Unisys property; but they declined Mr. Tyler's request to act as sponsors or hosts to same.

There being no further business to come before the Board, and keeping in mind the commencement of Town Meeting this evening at 7:30 p.m., the meeting was adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
