

IN BOARD OF SELECTMEN
TUESDAY, MAY 28, 1991

Present: Chairman David A. Wallace, John C. Drobinski and Judith A. Cope.

The statutory requirements as to notice having been fulfilled, Chairman Wallace called the special meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. in the Loring Parsonage.

Town Treasurer and Collector Appointment

Present: Town Accountant James Vanar and former Town Treasurer and Collector Chester Hamilton.

On May 13, 1991, the Selectmen interviewed applicants for the position of Town Treasurer and Collector. This evening, following discussion, the Board of Selectmen, on motion unanimously

VOTED: To appoint Mary Ellen Normen Dunn to the position of Town Treasurer and Collector, subject to the Executive Secretary meeting with Ms. Dunn and working out the details of employment conditions and salary.

The Board of Selectmen directed the Executive Secretary to inform the other finalist candidates of the Board's decision immediately and express its appreciation for applying for the position. [Later in the evening, the Executive Secretary did notify all candidates of the Board's selection. In addition, the Executive Secretary notified the Treasurer and Collector office personnel of the Board's decision the following morning.]

Water District

On other business, the Executive Secretary updated the Board that, through the suggestion of Selectman Cope, he had requested the Water District Superintendent Richard Carroll to ask their special counsel (Attorney Thomas F. Holt, Jr. of Brown, Rudnick, Freed & Gesmer) for the Unisys property to arrange a meeting with Town Counsel as soon as possible so that they might collaborate with each other.

Also, at the suggestion of Selectman Cope, the Executive Secretary will follow up with Mr. Carroll on the method used in the water line flushing program as it relates to washouts.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 5:35 p.m.
