The statutory requirements as to notice having been complied with, the meeting was convened by Chairman Drobinski at 7:00 p.m. in the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School Library.

Walkway Program - Articles 19, 39, 51

The Board received a copy of a draft report of the Planning Board and Walkway Program Committee providing recommendations to the Annual Town Meeting concerning the three walkway articles on the Warrant.

Art. 30 - Water Resource Protection Districts Bylaw

The Board received a memorandum dated April 13, 1993, from the Planning Board requesting the Board's position on the following proposals regarding Article 30.

Relative to Question 1 as to the Board's position on keeping all the language intact except for G.5.b.7) and J.5.e.f), both of which would read 1000 gallons per day per 40,000 square feet, in discussion Selectman Blacker said he does not support this idea, and Selectmen Drobinski and Cope withheld any position because they felt they needed more technical review.

Relative to Question 2 as to the Planning Board recommending referral of the article back to committee for presentation to a future Town Meeting, the Selectmen unanimously supported same.

Elected Officials Sick Leave BuyBack Appropriation

In review of the discussion paper dated April 14, 1993, prepared by the Budget and Personnel Officer and the Executive Secretary, the Board of Selectmen unanimously agreed with Option 1, which eliminates Sick Leave Buyback appropriations for both of Sudbury's elected officials.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
