

IN BOARD OF SELECTMEN
SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEETING
TUESDAY, DECEMBER 21, 1993

Present: Chairman Judith A. Cope and John C. Drobinski.

The meeting was posted as an emergency meeting in order to have time to accomplish the processing of the gift of a parcel of land to the Town in the current calendar year. At 3:00 p.m., Chairman Drobinski convened the meeting in the Loring Parsonage, 288 Old Sudbury Road.

Montopoli Property, Water Row

The Board was in receipt of a communication dated December 17, 1993, from the Conservation Commission and a letter dated December 16, 1993, from Jennaro Montopoli to the Conservation Commission setting forth an offer from Mr. Montopoli to gift to the Town three parcels of land on Water Row which abut the King Philip Conservation land and Great Meadows National Wildlife land, provided the transfer can take place before the close of 1993.

Following discussion, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To accept on behalf of the Town the following parcels of land located on Water Row, owned by Jennaro Montopoli, subject to Town Counsel approving and preparing documents therefor:

Parcel 1, Map H-11, Block 011, Book 00629, Page 0171

Parcel 2, Map H-11, Block 012, Book 00629, Page 0171

Parcel 3, Map H-11, Block 013, Book 00629, Page 0171

The Board of Selectmen directed the Executive Secretary to have the Hazardous Waste Coordinator view the sites for possible contamination and report back. [Note: Coordinator Robert Leupold subsequently reported verbally after investigation that he sees no problem with the parcels]

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 3:10 p.m.
