The statutory requirements as to notice having been met, the meeting was convened at 7:30 p.m. at the Sudbury Housing Authority offices, 55 Hudson Road, by Chairman Blacker.

Building Department

On recommendation of Executive Secretary Richard E. Thompson that, due to the current incapacity of John B. Hepting, the Building Inspector, and the willingness of Charles Willett, the Building Inspector of Maynard, to assist the Town of Sudbury, the Board on motion unanimously

VOTED: To appoint Charles Willett as interim Deputy Building Inspector for the Town of Sudbury for an indefinite term.

Fire Department - Contracted Services Account

Fire Chief Dunne requested the support of the Board to increase Fiscal Year 1995 and 1996 budgets by \$1,500 and \$2,500 respectively due to projections that the Fire Contracted Services Line Item 2200-5236 will be underfunded. It was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To recommend increase of the Fiscal Year 1995 budget by \$1,500 and 1996 by \$2,500 for Fire Department Contracted Services and to approve use of the Ambulance Reserve for Appropriation Account to fund same. It is understood the 1995 amount will be amended in Article 5 of the upcoming Annual Town Meeting and 1996 will be amended by the Finance Committee in their main budget motion.

Upon recommendation by the Executive Secretary, the Board of Selectmen, on motion unanimously

VOTED: To release \$9,000 of the appropriation under 1988 Special Town Meeting Article 18 - Aquifer \$10,000, to be applied to the FY96 Budget as listed below; \$1,000 to be retained in said Article for its stated purpose.

Foreclosures

VOTED: To accept the recommendation of Town Counsel to bring a resolution of the Powers Road and North Road properties by taking such steps as are necessary in Land Court in order for the Town to recover the taxes, interest and expenses.
