FY04 Operating Budget

The Town Manager presented the Board of Selectmen with several options for dealing with the Budget Article at Town Meeting, given the state aid uncertainties. These options included the possibility of postponing the budget article until some time in May, cutting the budget now to adjust to worst case Local Aid scenario, or leaving the budget as it is, which means presenting Town Meeting with a potentially unbalanced budget.

The Board asked the Town Manager to invite the Finance Committee and both school committees to their meeting on March 25 to discuss these options with them.
