Special Election - Highway Commission (8:00 P.M.)

Following notice to the Highway Commission, in a communication dated August 19, 1974, (notice posted August 20, 1974), of the Board's vote on August 15, 1974, to call a special election to fill the vacancy on the Highway Commission occasioned by the resignation of Mr. Ronald P. Espinola, and in accordance with Chapter 41, Section 11, of the General Laws, as amended, the Board of Selectmen met at 8:00 p.m. in joint session with the Highway Commission for the purpose of balloting on candidates to fill said vacancy.

On motion moved and seconded, it was by both boards unanimously

VOTED: To confirm the appointment of Richard E. Thompson, Executive Secretary, to serve as clerk for the meeting of the Board of Selectmen and the Highway Commission held for the purpose of electing a new member to the Highway Commission to fill the existing vacancy.

The following nominations were made and seconded:

Donald D. Bishop, 80 Raymond Road

Nominations were closed and on the first roll call ballot, Donald D. Bishop was elected by a majority of the joint session (5-1) to fill the existing vacancy on the Highway Commission.
