

IN BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MONDAY, APRIL 5, 1976

Present: Chairman William F. Toomey, John C. Powers, and Ira M. Potell

The statutory requirements as to notice having been complied with, the meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman William F. Toomey.

Highway Surveyor - Appointment as Agent for Sanitary Landfill Operation and Street Lighting

As requested by the Board at its meeting with the Highway Surveyor on March 31, 1976, the Board received a communication dated April 1, 1976 from the Highway Surveyor, which expressed his interest in and willingness to accept the responsibility for any and all of the 400 accounts previously administered by the Highway Commission.

Following discussion, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To appoint Robert A. Noyes as the Selectmen's agent for purposes of operation of the sanitary landfill at no compensation;

and it was further

VOTED: To appoint Robert A. Noyes as the Selectmen's agent for purposes of street lighting at no compensation.

Petition - Sudbury Highway Department Employees for Weekly Payment of Wages

The Board held further discussion on a petition dated February 10, 1976 from the Highway Department employees relative to weekly payment of their wages in accordance with GLc149 §148, which had been discussed at the March 31, 1976 meeting, following which, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To authorize the Executive Secretary to implement the request of the Highway Department as soon as practicable.

It was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To approve the minutes of the special meetings of March 30 and March 31, 1976.

Proclamation - Sudbury Earth Week

It was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To sign a proclamation which designated April 25 - May 1, 1976 as Sudbury Earth Week and which invited all residents of the Town to join groups that will assemble at the Town Hall at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 1, 1976, to participate in picking up litter from the Sudbury roadsides, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Article 2 - April 7 Special Town Meeting - Account 310-12 Fire Overtime

Selectman Potell reported that the Finance Committee had on April 1, 1976 voted to increase the appropriation figure for Account 310-12, Fire Overtime, over that printed in the warrant.

Mr. Potell suggested that the Board meet with the Finance Committee for discussion of this matter.

The Executive Secretary was requested to schedule a meeting for this purpose on April 6, 1976 at 7:30 p.m.

Article 7 Annual Town Meeting - Garage Sale Signs

Present: Robert Cooper, Edward Connors, Albert St. Germain, and Richard Brooks of the Planning Board; Emmanuel Tiliakos, Town Planner; Francis E. White, Building Inspector

As requested in their letter of March 29, 1976, members of the Planning Board and the Building Inspector met with the Board to discuss Article 7 - Garage Sale Signs.


Mr. Cooper stated that, in the Planning Board's opinion, a problem exists with the present wording of the article; specifically, that all goods to be sold at a given garage sale must be the property of the occupant of the premises.

After discussion with Town Counsel, it was agreed to amend the present article by striking the provisions in the first sentence, so that the first sentence will read, "The Building Inspector may grant, without a hearing, upon proper application, a permit to display a 'Garage Sale' sign, provided that such permit shall be limited to a specific day, shall only be granted to the occupant of the premises where the sale is to be conducted, and shall specify the size of the sign."

There being no further business to come before the Board, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To adjourn the meeting at 8:00 p.m.
