Emergency Special Town Meeting

It was on motion by Selectman Hotch unanimously

VOTED: In accordance with the request dated May 16, 1979 from the Sudbury School Committee, to call an Emergency Special Town Meeting to be held on June 11, 1979, at 9:00 p.m., in the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School Auditorium, for the sole purpose of considering an article which reads as follows:

"To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or appropriate from available funds, the sum of \$66,000, or any other sum, in addition to the funds voted under Article 5 of the 1979 Annual Town Meeting for Account 110 - Sudbury Public Schools, to be expended under the direction and control of the Sudbury School Committee; or act on anything relative thereto."

The Board of Selectmen executed the Emergency Special Town Meeting Warrant for June 11, 1979, to be submitted to the printer for inclusion with the Special Town Meeting Warrant for the same date.

There being no further business to come before the Board, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To adjourn the meeting at 9:10 p.m.
