

IN BOARD OF SELECTMEN
THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 1986

Present: Chairman Josiah F. Frost, Anne W. Donald and David A. Wallace.

The statutory requirements as to notice having been fulfilled, the meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School Library.

Special Town Meeting

After discussion, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To support the Resolution under Article 20 and to speak as individuals on Articles 18 and 19.

There was a consensus of the Board to support Articles 18 and 19 if Article 18 were amended to restrict the zone to the Mercury property.

The Board acknowledged receipt of a communication dated September 23, 1986, from the Conservation Commission relative to its withdrawal of Article 5, Maintenance - Conservation Property, from consideration at the Special Town Meeting.

Tax Classification

Pursuant to the public hearing of September 15, 1986, for the purpose of determining what percentage of the local tax levy will be borne by each class of real and personal property relative to setting the FY86-87 tax rate, after review of the options as presented by the Board of Assessors and the Town Accountant, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To select a residential factor of .929402, subject to the final actions of the Special Town Meeting resulting in a tax levy of \$15,819,042.

The Board also acknowledged receipt of a letter from Assistant Assessor Daniel Loughlin, dated September 23, 1986, which in part stated that the Assessors had decided not to attend the continued public hearing.

The Board also acknowledged receipt of a September 22 letter from Board of Assessors Chairman Linda Z. Buxbaum suggesting that future fall Special Town Meetings be held earlier to avoid delaying the setting of the tax rates.

Executive Session

At 7:45 p.m., it was on motion by roll call

VOTED: To enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing expenditures from the Discretionary Fund.

(Chairman Frost, in favor; Selectman Donald, in favor; Selectman Wallace, in favor.)

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
