

IN BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
TUESDAY, APRIL 7, 1987

Present: Chairman Anne W. Donald and David A. Wallace.

The statutory requirements as to notice having been fulfilled, the meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Library of the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School.

Route 20 - Central Transportation Planning Staff Improvement Plans

The Board noted receipt of a copy of a request made by the State's Central Transportation Planning Staff (CTPS), dated April 2, to Police Chief Peter Lembo for detailed accident data relative to the portion of Route 20 within Sudbury for the years 1984, 1985 and 1986, and the total number of accidents within the Town for those years. The request was made to facilitate an analysis of the road's accident history in conjunction with CTPS development of improvement plans for the portion of Route 20 between I-495 and Route 128. The Executive Secretary will obtain a copy of the Chief's response.

Annual Town Meeting

The Board discussed its positions and substance of presentations to be made on articles remaining to be considered in the Annual Town Meeting.

Selectman Wallace noted that he had received a copy of the "Proposed Resolution Concerning Package Sewage Treatment Plants", copy of which had been forwarded by the Conservation Commission to Town Counsel Paul L. Kenny. The Board agreed that the core of the Resolution is the issue of residential land development. Town Counsel opined that such an issue might best be approached in a different manner than this non-binding Resolution, which instructs the Board of Health or other permit issuing authority to implement a moratorium on the development of such residential systems in the Town of Sudbury. Mr. Kenny explained that sewage treatment plants are regulated at this time by the DEQE and not the local Board of Health.

There being no further business to come before the board, the meetins was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
