Trailer Permit - 8 Stock Farm Road

The Board was in receipt of a letter dated March 1, 1988, from Vernon Clark of 8 Stock Farm Road, requesting temporary use of a trailer to live in while his family's home is being repaired after a fire. Accordingly, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To grant a special permit for use of a house trailer at 8 Stock Farm Road, for dwelling purposes for six months while fire damage repairs are being made, to Vernon Clark, subject to obtaining any required building permit and Board of Health approval involving the requirement to connect the trailer to septic system and town water.

Waive Grave Opening fee

Upon request by Veterans Agent Paul J. Leahy, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To waive the fee relative to grave opening at Wadsworth Cemetery for the burial of Mary Freeman.
