The statutory requirements as to time and place having been fulfilled, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Wallace at 7:00 p.m., at the library of the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School.

Walk For Hunger

Present: Tom Kruskal.

The Board reviewed letter dated March 30, 1989, from Tom Kruskal of 136 Lincoln Road, and letter dated May 7, 1989, from Brad Hubbell, Inter-Generational Committee, First Parish of Sudbury, requesting support and permission to allow a town-wide Walk For Hunger on Sunday, May 7, 1989, in conjunction with Operation Bread's Walk in Boston.

Upon review of the map provided by Mr. Hubbell outlining the proposed route, and further noting that this Walk raises money to feed and aid the homeless, it was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To grant permission for the Sudbury Walk For Hunger, in support of Operation Bread, to take place on Sunday, May 7, 1989, following a route commencing at the First Parish Church in Sudbury Centre and concluding at the Memorial Congregational Church on Concord Road, subject to coordination with the Sudbury Police Department; and it was further

VOTED: To allow the Sudbury Walk For Hunger to advertise on the community bulletin boards located on Routes 20 and 117, from Sunday, April 30, through Saturday, May 6, 1989.

There being no further business to come before the Board, and due to the commencement of Town Meeting, the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
