IN BOARD OF SELECTMEN
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 17, 1989

Present: Chairman John C. Drobinski, Judith A. Cope, and David A. Wallace.

The statutory requirements as to notice having been fulfilled, the special meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Drobinski in the Library of the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School.

Special Town Meeting Art. 6 - Research District No. 1

The Board met with members of the Planning Board and it was agreed to amend the motion approved on October 16 to refer Article 6, as follows:

By substituting the words, "To refer the matter to the Selectmen and the Planning Board who shall establish a committee...", in place of the words, "To refer the matter to the Selectmen who shall work in conjunction with the Planning Board to establish a committee...".

It was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To recess the meeting to attend the Special Town Meeting and to continue this meeting following action under Articles 4 and 5 and the close of tonight's session of the Special Town Meeting to take action relative to the Special Town Election.

At the recess of the Special Town Meeting, Chairman Drobinski resumed the Selectmen's meeting.

Special Town Election

It was on motion unanimously

VOTED: To approve the following ballot question for the November 20, 1989 Special Town Election Warrant:

Ballot Question No. 1

Shall the Town of Sudbury be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond issued in order to remodel, reconstruct and make extraordinary repairs to the Nixon and Noyes School buildings (including asbestos removal) and the building or buildings to which the School Department Administrative Offices will be relocated; and to purchase additional equipment and furnishings for the Nixon and Noyes School buildings, as voted and approved by the October 17, 1989 Special Town Meeting under Article 5.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:30 a.m., October 18, 1989.
