Maureen seems to be restricting use of the Town Hall to government organizations. Therefore, Historical Society is not allowed to be in there. We were unaware of this policy so we wonder if we should equip the library for video next since the Community Room is totally public.

Ceiling camera for Town Hall will be decided this coming year, purchased from capital fund.

Mark and other employees would like to see how to use the Town Hall studio.
