CIPC Meeting notes January 6, 2011

Meeting started at 7PM. - 1. Approval of previous meeting minutes: Pascal motioned, Larry second, unanimous approval
- 2. Discussion of Noyes repair project
 - a. One time chance for towns to obtain stimulus funding. Sudbury invited to participate in program on 11/17; required town to approve funding w/in 90 days
 - b. Asking for replacement of roof, boiler & windows total cost \$2.6MM (\$200K added to original estimate to account for market conditions and potential for asbestos)
 - c. Noyes built in 1951, major addition in 1970, roof last replaced in 1985, boilers are from 1970, 55% of windows are from 1970 and 45% of windows are from 1985
 - d. All supported by PBC, Mass. School Building Authority, consultanting engineering firms; MSBA to contribute 35.4%
 - e. Discussion about operating costs savings (~\$40K-\$45K per year)
 - f. Discussion about contingency plans in the event the work is not done by the beginning of the school year work can be done in off hours
 - g. Discussion about what happens if asbestos or PCB's are found part of the extra \$200K added to the contingency if for this
- 3. Discussion of Nixon non-addressable fire alarms
 - a. Have 12 zones, but each could have as many as 12 fire alarms
 - b. When an alarm goes off, the zone is known but not the specific alarm. Need to go around searching for the alarm that is going off.
 - c. Nixon is only school that does not have addressable fire alarm system
 - d. \$90,000 cost
 - e. Not necessarily student safety issue, but relevant for protecting the town's asset
- 4. Discussion of building requests
 - a. Pick up truck to replace old truck
 - b. Various building improvements annual request for \$35K
 - i. Senior center roof cost 2X what was budgeted; previous years' VBI funds are being used to accomplish this task in FY11
 - ii. Police roof is 1-2 years away from needing to be replaced
 - iii. Needs to have these funds to be flexible in responding to immediate building needs
- 5. Committee discussion on Noyes repair projects
- 6. Motion to support article one of special town meeting to replace the roof, boilers and windows at Peter Noyes School through the MSBA Green Repair program
 - a. Thomas moved, Jose seconded, 6 voted for, 0 against, unanimous approval
