# Town of Sudbury, Massachusetts Minutes of the CIAC Meeting February 16, 2016

1. Acceptance of minutes:

Minutes of the January 26, 2016 meeting were approved.

- 2. Review of Tom Travers's draft report to the Board of Selectmen and Finance Committee
  - a. Discussed Recommended Reductions to original proposals (proposed funding decreased or not recommended **at this time**):
    - Park and Rec does not seem to strongly support Featherland tennis court project. CIAC recommends submitting to CPC for funding next year
    - ii. Playground resurfacing: although CIAC recommends deferring this project to next year and applying to CPC for funding, we do want to make sure the playground is usable and safe in its current condition.
    - iii. Other changes as noted in report
  - b. Fairbank Community Center: the CIAC does not have enough information to present a recommendation on the community center project at this time. We expect the Community Center Committee will present a more complete plan to our committee some time before town meeting, at which time we will opine on the project.
  - c. Publication of our recommendations? Tom indicated that the CIAC report will be incorporated into the Annual Report of the Town of Sudbury. Jim suggested that the CIAC recommendations also be published in the warrant for Annual Town Meeting.
- 3. Vote on Proposed Projects

#### **Proposed Capital Exclusions:**

a. School Rooftop HVAC \$75,000 Recommend approval unanimous

b. School and Town Security Access Code \$195,000

Recommend approval unanimous

c. Town and School Parking lots \$150,000

Recommend approval unanimous

(Note lower amount than original request-see report)

d. Security Improvement Upgrade at LSRHS \$130,000

Recommend approval unanimous

There were questions/confusion about whether interior cameras are being proposed and/or already exist at LS

e. Nixon Crosswalk Safety Crossing Light \$25,000

Recommend approval unanimous

There was some discussion about the location of a new sidewalk. The cost of the sidewalk is not included in this cost.

(Note lower amount than original request-see report.)

f. DPQ Truck Replacements \$492,000

Recommend approval unanimous g. SPS Maintenance Garage \$95,000

Recommend approval 4-1 (because of uncertainty of location)
There were questions about the location of the garage. It will most likely be at Nixon, but not sure exactly where.

h. Fuel Storage Replacement \$250,000

i. Town Walkways \$100,000 unanimous Recommend approval unanimous

(Note recommendation to fund by capital exclusion rather than CPC because of pending lawsuit in another town over use of CPA funds for walkways.)

j. Ambulance Replacement \$265,000
 Recommend approval unanimous
 k. DPW Cold Storage \$225,000
 Recommend approval unanimous
 There were some questions about cost and size.

#### **Proposed Debt Exclusions:**

a. Ladder Truck Replacement \$875,000

Recommend approval unanimous

b. Fairbank Roof Replacement \$1,000,000 This article will not be proposed at Town Meeting

c. Administrative Building for SPS \$5,500,000

This article will not be proposed at Town Meeting

See notes in report re: roof replacement, SPS administrative offices

### **Proposed Other Projects (CPA Funding):**

a. Loring Parsonage Restoration \$100,000

Recommend approval unanimous

(Note lower amount than original request. The CIAC recommends to the CPC to fund \$100,000 of this project to "kick start" the fundraising campaign. The recommended approval is subject to understanding how the \$100,000 would be used.)

b. Town Center Landscape \$100,000

Recommend approval unanimous

c. Library Archive Software \$40,000 The CIAC takes no position as the cost is less than \$50,000 and the project wasn't presented to the CIAC

d. Bruce Freeman Rail Trail Design Fees for 50% approval \$150,000 Recommend approval unanimous

e. Davis Field Renovations \$148,500
Recommend approval unanimous subject to quote from DPW to perform this work
