Dear Ms. Middleton:

I return the amendments to the general by-laws adopted under articles 20, 22, 24, 25, 26, 28 and 43 of the warrant for the Sudbury annual town meeting that convened on April 6, 1998, with the enclosed approval of this Office. In approving article 43 which amends Section 3, the Town's Regulation of Dog by-law, may I caution you that the revolving fund established therein pursuant to G.L. c. 44, § 53E ½ requires a separate annual appropriation by town meeting in order to become effective. When so voted annually, expenditures may then be made from the fund for the stated program purposes, but subject to the provisions of Section 53E 1/2.
