- A- VOTER: If there is an asterisk (*) in this column, that person is a registered voter in Sudbury.
- **B-** NAME: List all persons whose legal address is at the top of the form. Include children, college students, in the military or in a care facility.
- C- MAIL TO: Place a "Y" in this column next to the mailing contact's name if one is not designated. Or you can cross out and change if desired. Only one head of household.
- **D- DATE OF BIRTH**: Use the month/day/year format.
- **E- OCCUPATION**: Enter occupation, not the place of employment. Enter "Student" for those enrolled inschool or college. Enter "Child" for those younger than school-age.
- **F- NATIONALITY**: Enter only if *NOT* a U.S. citizen.
