

Community Housing Committee
August 11, 2003
Minutes

The committee discussed the proposed interim housing goals prepared by the Town Planner. A meeting with the Selectmen on adoption of these goals will occur on August 12th. The committee agreed to present the goals as written.

P. Rosseel distributed a draft survey on housing preferences for town employees. He has reviewed several other town's surveys. The committee made several suggested changes to the survey, which will be distributed again at the next meeting.

The resident survey prepared by P. Rosseel was briefly discussed, and the members present did not think that this type of survey was relevant until goals and objectives have been formulated. It was not thought that the data received from a survey of residents would be helpful at this time, and may indicate negative opinions on moving forward and developing community housing.

The committee discussed the Housing Plan outline prepared by the Town Planner. A. Lepak volunteered to look into the market data needs of the plan. All members were encouraged to continue to review Lincoln and Scituate's housing plans for future meetings.
