Kablack distributed a document from the Town of Stow regarding criteria for 40B developments, which has been adopted as a policy by the Stow Selectmen. The document contains specific criteria that Stow will consider in granting friendly 40B permits. Many of these same criteria can be useful in Sudbury.

SHA Sites for Scattered Housing

After all the work this fall, there are 4 sites that have been identified for SHA housing:
Newbridge Road (1 duplex)
Landham Road (1 duplex)
Wilshire Road (being tested for soils)
Hudson Road (1 duplex)

HOME Consortium

Sudbury was voted into the West Metro HOME Consortium on January 8th. Funds will be available on July 1, 2005. \$10-\$15,000 per year is anticipated.
