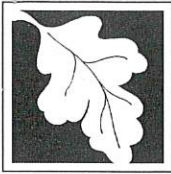


NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING SUDBURY CONSERVATION COMMISSION

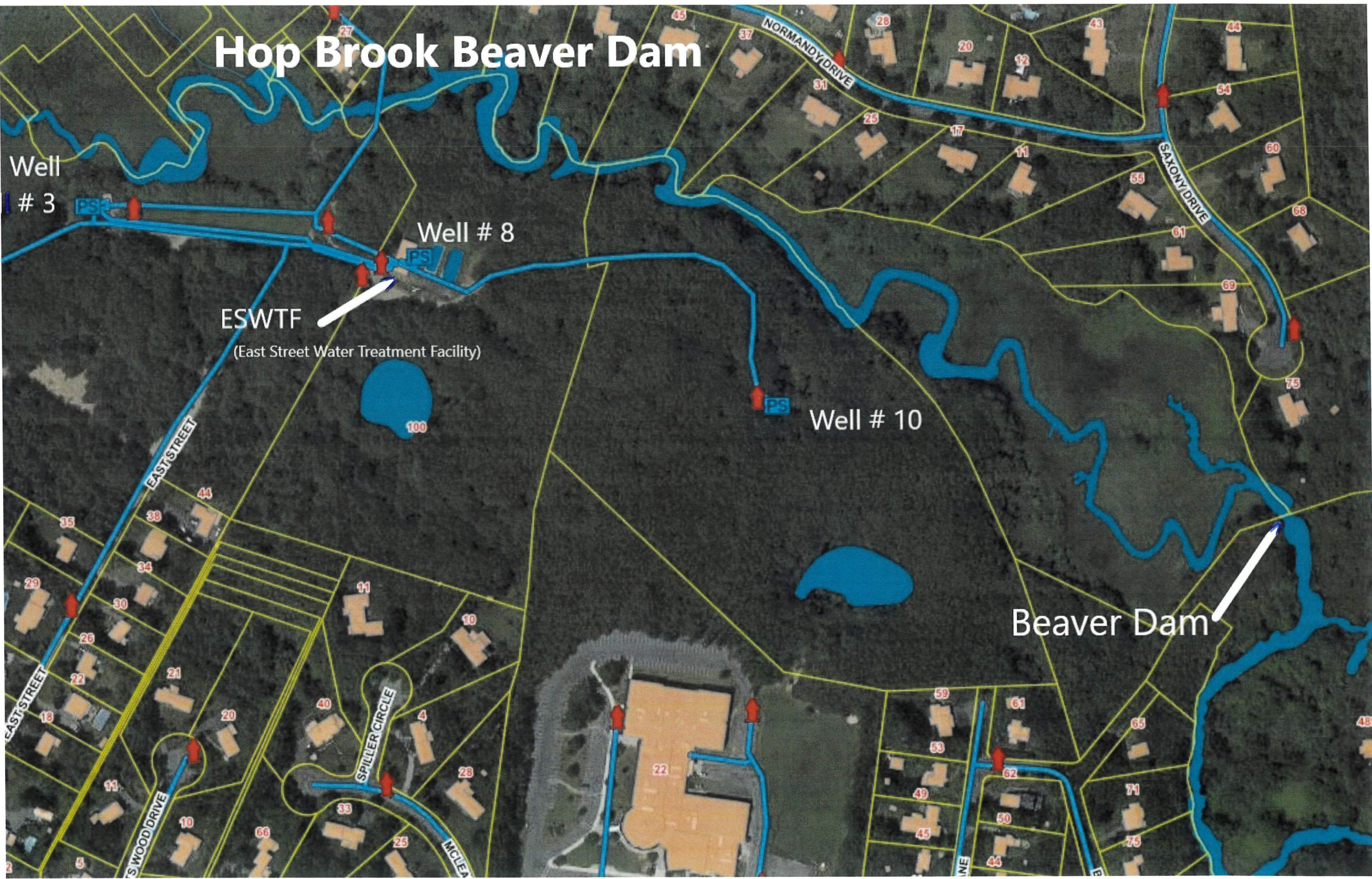

Hi Vincent,

It's nice to hear from you. I hope you are doing well in Sudbury.

Yes, we can do that. The cost varies upon the number of beavers and the number of days it takes to catch them all (usually 7 - 10). It usually is about \$1,200 to catch the entire colony. It is trapping season so we would not need a town permit unless you also need the dam breached. My trappers are very busy right now but upon approval I believe we could start as soon as next week.

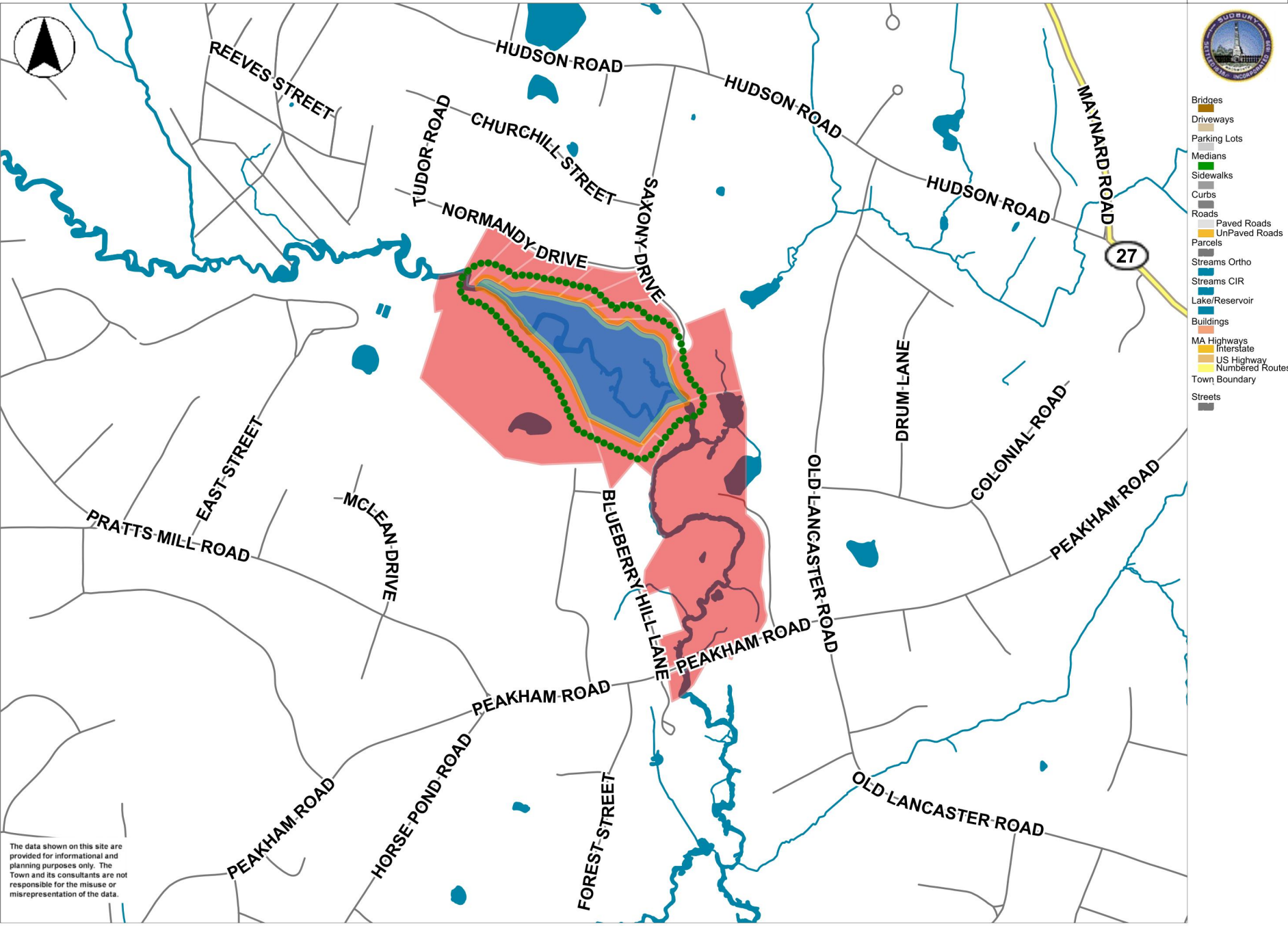
