We plan to remove six closely packed trees (see letter from arborist) which are located at the edge of the woods, near the border with the lawn (see As Built Plans with trees marked in red circles). Based on their height, a substantial portion of any one of the trees would hit the house should it fall toward the house. Several similarly sized white pines have fallen on our property in the last year. The trees are located completely within the Buffer Zone, and removal of the trees will not alter the resource area or the Buffer Zone boarders. Although there are ample additional trees and other vegetation in the area, we are happy to plant additional trees or bushes in place of the removed trees should the Commission request it.

To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Christopher Orchard, a certified arborist with Stumpy's Tree Service. On February 16, 2021 I visited the above address to conduct a basic visual assessment of several trees on the property for their health and structure.

- 37 inch Diameter at Breast Height (DBH) White Pine. Tree seems to be in fair health with a normal amount of foliage and good color. This Pine has a co-dominant stem with a large defect at the union.
- There are four other White Pines in question. They range from 20"-26" DBH. They are all single stem and have signs of past storm damage and poor form. No lower foliage is present.
- Last is a 13"DBH Oak. This tree has been damaged in past storms that resulted in a broken top, close to 50% of the tree

All of the above listed trees have structural deficiencies and significant level of risk to the property. Site History would also indicate an issue with the more mature trees in this area, several Pines have broken and/or unrooted. Due to the above listed deficiencies plus their size and location in relation to targets, the house. I would deem them all a hazard. I recommend the trees to be removed.
