To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Christopher Orchard, a certified arborist with Stumpy's Tree Service. On December 07, 2020 I visited the above address to perform a basic visual inspection of several trees on the property.

- The first tree is a 27" diameter at breast height Maple left of the house. This Maple is in poor health with over 50% of the crown still alive.
- The second is a 17" DBH Oak also left of the house. Oak is in fair health but has a very Heavy lean towards the neighbors property.
- Third is a 30" DBH Maple left side of the property. Maple is in poor health, extensive decay at the base was found along with significant cracks on the main stem.
- Fourth is a 29"DBH Maple at rear of the house. Said tree is in fair health, however cavities and spiral cracks are present on the main stem.
- Fifth is a 22"DBH Maple at the rear of the house. Tree is in poor health, past storms have damaged the crown leaving very little behind. Towards the base a cavity was found.
- Sixth is a 26" diameter Maple. Tree is in fair health, however no trunk flare is visible and decay present at base.
- The Last tree is a 23" Maple right of the house. Tree is in poor health with roughly 50% of the crown dead. Extensive decay found low on the stem.

In my opinion the above mentioned trees, due to their proximity to targets and severe defects, should be considered hazards to the property. I recommend them to be removed.




