Notice of Intent

NARRATIVE Mary Mullin 14 Revere Street Map K05 Parcel 407

The project consists of the replacement of an existing cracked pump chamber installed in 2008.

The subject parcel is located at 14 Revere Street and consists of an existing dwelling with a land area of approximately 40,100 s.f. The parcel abuts a vegetated wetland.

The existing Soil Absorption System (SAS) in the front of the dwelling was installed in 2008. Upon inspection of the pump chamber, located in the rear and left side of the property, it was found to be cracked and in need of replacement.


The access will be directly off of Revere Street as shown on the attached plan. This access will require the grade in the front yard be reduced to allow the delivery truck access to the install the new pump chamber. The access will require the removal of approximately eight (8) rhododendron bushes, one (1) hydrangea and two (2) spruce trees (less than 6" dbh – one appears dead) to remove the existing pump chamber and install the new pump chamber.

The erosion control barrier (straw wattles) is proposed between the work area and the resource area to ensure protection of the resource area. There shall be a minimum amount of stockpiling due to the nature of the replacement.

No work shall commence onsite until erosion control barriers have been installed and inspected by the Conservation Commission.
