



USGS TOPO MAP MAYMARD 2021




USGS Topographic Maps Property Tax Parcels









A6: General Project Description;

We are applying to remove 5 (five) mature pine trees that present an imminent danger of falling onto our home (see identifying locations on attached MassMapper page titled "68 Willard Grant Rd. NOI" for location of identified trees relative to the parcel/structure/wetlands). Our intent is to cut the trees to near ground level — not grinding or removing the stumps. The plan would be to bring in a very large crane to remove the trees section-by-section back to the street for further processing and final removal.

NOTE: As can be seen in the photos, there are existing Burning Bush shrubs in the foreground. These are already to the south of the current tree line and will not be receiving any additional exposure after the proposed tree removal. We do offer as mitigation to remove any identifiable intrusive species (i.e., burning bush), that lie within the identified cut area.
