B. Project Description

1. b Area Description:

The site is an approximately 76,057 SF single family residence lot located in Sudbury, Massachusetts with a Wooded Wetland along the Eastern property line. Over time previous owners have encroached upon the wetland buffer. A fairly level lawn area of approximately 7,000 SF now exists between the house and the BVW with in the 100 foot buffer area and is in need of restoration.



2. a. Activity/Work Description:

The object of the project is to restore the existing lawn area located in the buffer zone adjacent to the BVW. The work includes: removing the existing lawn area, installing bounds to indicate the "no mow" line, and installing 12 Native Trees and 32 Native Shrubs (see plant list on Sheet 3 of 3 for the specific plants). The ground plane will be seeded with a Native Seed Mix as specified by New England Wetland Plants according to the light and soil conditions of the site. Erosion Control will be installed pre-construction along the current disturbance line in order to prevent further disturbance of the resource area.
