Sequence of Work: 1. File a Request for Determination of Applicability with the Conservation Commission. for approval to implement the restoration plan.

2. Meet with landscaper and Conservation Coordinator to discuss and approve plantings and extent of the plantings. 3. Perform planting in Spring, no later than 1 June. The area shall be allowed to naturalize once planted with no further management.

4. Inform new owners of Conservation Restriction and use requirements.

Remove lawn clipping pile.

Plant area within dotted line with: Highbush blueberry (Vaccinium corymbosum), 3 to 4 ft. in height. Other native shrubs can be substituted with prior approval from the Town of Sudbury Conservation Coordinator. Provide 40 individual bushes and space evenly. Adjust spacing as necessary to avoid rocks and outcroppings. Maintain a 100 sq. ft. (ca. 12 ft. dia. circle) around existing trees clear of plantings.
