Project Name: Multiple Project Submission:

1, Hosmer House Fire Suppression System, 2, Continuation of the Old Home Survey, 3, Restoration of wooden structure component of the "Pound" .

Project Description:

1. To have installed a tank and pump fire suppression system at the town owned Hosmer House at 299 Old Sudbury Road. This system would primarily be for the protection of Hosmer House, built in 1793, and the 400 + paintings in a rotating display there. The system would also provide a safety feature to patrons during open houses and community events. Estimated Cost: \$56,000.00.
2. To continue the Survey of homes, buildings and locations, as required by the Mass historical Commission, with 10 properties identified to be added to the Towns survey inventory. Estimated Cost: \$5,000.00.
3. Restoration of the wooden component of the walls and gate at the town owned Town Pound, first built in 1797 for the sum of \$20.00, now needing restoration of the 10" timbers on the top of the stone wall and restoration of the gate. Estimated cost: \$6,000.00.
