Sudbury Housing Authority report on Blue Ribbon Housing Site Selection Committee

- 10 Parcels, semi-final list
- Board of Selectmen Meeting on December 8
- Proposal for site investigation - Housing Authority proposal for funding in this year's CPC budget is formally withdrawn
- Housing Authority will re-apply for Administrative funds after completion of the site-selection process.
- Discussed priority for Sudbury residents and employees (including METCO students) - None currently on list; list is one year + wait
- Existing housing; significant number of Sudbury residents in SHA units

Walkway Construction

- Letters of support from the Board of Selectmen, the Town Manager and the Planning Board
- Discussion of Park & Recreation jurisdiction; Park & Recreation does not feel it is within the scope of recreation activity that they want to endorse
- Discussion about purpose of referral and impact of Park & Recreation decision to the CPC
- Recreation Category; Question about appropriateness for CPA funding
- Carole Wolfe expressed concern about aesthetics
- Vote to recommend walkways proposal as a semi-finalists was 7-2

Revolutionary War Cemetery

- Vote to recommend cemetery proposal as a semi-finalist was unanimous

Cutting

- Vote to recommend Cutting (Open Space) proposal as a semi-finalist was unanimous
- Vote to recommend Cutting (Recreation) proposal as a semi-finalist was unanimous
