Project Name: Historic Property Survey III

The Sudbury Historical Commission believes that this project is within the guidelines of the Community Preservation Act.

This proposal is for Phase III of a survey that was first started in 1996 in which 156 properties were identified and evaluated as to their historic relevance. Phase II was completed in 2008 when an additional 33 property surveys were completed and published with the assistance of CPA funds. This request is to continue identifying properties in Sudbury and is the third phase of a projected four-phase project.

This project is scheduled to be completed within a three year time frame.

This project meets the CPA criteria under the Historical category for the following reasons:

1. The survey is used by multiple Town departments and commissions to identify specific properties in their historic preservation planning efforts to protect and preserve historic, cultural and archaeological resources of significance to the town.
2. The Sudbury Historical Commission has successfully directed this Historic Properties survey project according to all MA State guidelines as provided by, and as required by, the Massachusetts Historical Commission.
3. The SHC is planning this phase to identify and survey the remaining "individual" properties meeting the MHC guidelines.
4. The funding requested is an amount that has been determined by the commission based on historical costs and projected expenses.
