Project Name: Featherland Tennis Court / Multi-Sport Reconstruction

<u>Project Description:</u> Reconstruct the tennis courts at Featherland Park. The Commission still has work to do and is beginning to discuss some multi-sport scenarios (tennis, basketball, pickle ball for example) that would enhance the recreational quality of life for the town. The addition of lights would offer a unique facility for after-work and after-dinner tennis and basketball for adults and families – particularly in the Fall. Controls would be in place to ensure lights are off prior to the time the baseball lights are turned off – no later than 9:00 pm.

Why is this project necessary?

1. To return (and improve upon) an important recreational asset to the neighborhood and town.
