Discussion on accessible bikes on the railtrails:

Karyn Jones led this discussion and provided information and research.

- All Out Adventures runs an accessible bike program in surrounding towns. They bring a big box truck with these bikes and do a day event from 10am - 3pm. Participants register through All Out Adventures. They have insurance. They offer these opportunities 2 - 5 times. All Out Adventures brings volunteers, but really great to get the rail trail volunteers involved
- Cost: \$2500 per community ride.
- People can sign up for an hour increment.
- Grants from Sudbury Foundation
- Natick does 6 a year and they are sponsored by MathWorks
- Action: Karyn to reach out to local Rail Trail Group(s) about their interest.
 - COD interested in funding this event if there is support from rail trail groups
