D. The AV consultant has provided the design and engineering for the Work shown in the documents. The AV subcontractor's integrator shall produce drawings that meet the AV subcontractor's standards, labeling, and cable types. The integrator is not engineering the AV design.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Article 2. Intent

Add the following paragraph and subparagraphs at the end of Article 2.

The Audio-Visual Contractor shall provide the following system updates, including all equipment and labor, necessary for a complete and operational system.

- 1. Multipurpose Room: Provide an XLR input and output (Mic Level) on a rack panel, connected to the audio DSP.
- 2. Program Room 5: Provide an XLR input and output (Mic Level) on a rack panel, connected to the audio DSP.
- 3. Training Rooms: Provide an XLR input and output (Mic Level) on a rack panel, connected to the audio DSP



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- 4. Gymnasium: Provide an XLR input and output (Mic Level) on a rack panel, connected to the audio DSP
- 5. Fitness Room: Provide an XLR input and output (Mic Level) on a rack panel, connected to the audio DSP





1. Questions Received from Bidder on October 25, 2023

General questions:

Any expected payment terms?

Response: Refer to Article 7 of Special Conditions, page 21 of 23

Is there an existing cable path available that will be reused? Response: Refer to Responsibility Schedule on Sheet AV.000

Is there any existing cable infrastructure that will be reused? Response: Refer to Responsibility Schedule on Sheet AV.000

In Project Manual, Article 3. Permits and Compliance with Code section states "The Town of Sudbury has waived all Town issued Permits". Confirm this means they will not require permits for the AV work.

Response: Speakers and audio equipment does not require a permit. POE ethernet is considered power and would require a permit. Cord and plug connected power from a receptacle outlet would not but hard wired would. Any cable or wires would need to be the correct type, i.e., no zip cord or Monster cable in concealed spaces. Anything to do with security, cameras, or access control would require a permit and a "S" license. There are many requirements in Chapter 8 of the NEC on these systems

Video Conferencing:

What is the video conferencing platform being used?

Response: AV Systems are designed for BYOD and should be agnostic to any platform.
