## **Agenda / Discussion Items**

- Welcomed and updated new Task Force members
  - o Sarah Troiano now voting member
  - Rick Johnson, Joe Sziabowski and Greg George need to have oath of office notarized and will then convert to voting members
- Warrant Article 17 Discussion
  - o Provided updates on outreach efforts to targeted private funding prospects for the proposed Feasibility Study:
    - Friends of Seniors: Indicated they would contribute up to \$17K if Friends of Park and Recreation would match.
    - *Friends of Park and Recreation:* No firm commitment, but conveyed opinion that participating in funding is within the scope of the *Friends*; currently in consensus building mode to secure participation.
    - *L-S Boosters:* Discussions are ongoing.
    - Park & Recreation Vendors: Park & Recreation declared that seeking funding from P&R vendors would not be appropriate.
    - Grant Application to the Sudbury Foundation has been submitted
      - Follow-up discussion scheduled for April 24<sup>th</sup>
      - Final answer is expected mid June
  - o Discussed Public Funding status for the proposed Feasibility Study:
    - Determined that magnitude of funding for Article 17 is considered a "capital" expense which requires submission to the Capital Improvement Planning Committee (CIPC) by October 1<sup>st</sup>
    - Since such submission did not take place, Article 17 will be adjusted to request a non-capital amount of <\$10,000, eliminating the need for CIPC submission.
    - Will seek this lesser amount via unused funding from a previously approved Article.
  - Reaffirmed strategy of seeking a coalition of both private and public funding for the Feasibility Study.
- Warrant Article 18 Discussion

- o Initial conversation with Town Manager indicates support for allocating unused funding from previously approved article to finance Article 18.
- Sudbury Public School Committee has voted to support both Article 17 and Article 18
