Posted Agenda for Meeting:

- 1) Review in more detail Option 3, so-called "60,000 sq. ft. plan" including issues of location and accommodation of existing users during construction;
- 2) Discussion of modifications to Option 3 including other options which may be considered or added;
- 3) Discussion of what other information or expertize may be need for completion of analysis and methods of obtaining that information or expertize.

Meeting Start & Minutes:

- Meeting convened at 7:35 pm
- Motion to approve 12/7 minutes by Greg George, seconded by Jim Kelly and approved unanimously

Agenda Related Discussion Items:

- Jim Kelly reported that recommendations from 12/7 meeting were shared with the BOS at their last meeting.
- Meeting attendees discussed what should be included in the Committee's final recommendation to the BOS. The following was agreed upon.
 - 1. Design option, including possible modifications
 - 2. Interim plan and staging
 - Committee recommends that building construction starts on the south side of building (on basket ball courts) first followed by move to north side; goal is to allow as much building use during construction as possible
 - 3. Location of the facility
 - Bryan Semple made motion to keep Community Center at the current Fairbank Road location; Rick Johnson seconded and it was voted in favor unanimously
 - 4. Consideration for impact to SPS:

- The Fairbank Committee recommends the Town consider building a second floor on the new community center to accommodate SPS' need for 9K square feet of program space, provided that it could be re-configured for Park & Rec and/or Senior Center needs in the future.
 - Sarah Troiano made a motion to vote on this recommendation;
 motion seconded by Greg George; approved unanimously

Detailed review of Option 3 conducted; observations and discussions of all committee members shared, including:

- Consensus to address "less than ideal spectator space"
- Need to understand the trade offs of redoing the deck on the existing pool
- Therapy pool pros and cons
- Office space acknowledgement that there is need for some confidential office space; but goal should be to have as flexible space as possible

Reviewed modification items/features the committee needs to address and validated the following:

- Existing pool: spectator space/wall trade off. Consensus that the spectator space even as proposed is not "ideal" and needs to be addressed in final design
- Therapy pool discussed this being a strong programmatic component for the senior population; agreed that should remain in final design

Identified specific program elements requiring further financial analysis

- Second pool discussed idea that we hold building a second pool in final design, but insist that the final design be built to accommodate construction of a second pool and splash park in the future; ensure blueprint for second pool in the design
- o Double gym with possible walking track

Additional Discussion Items:

- Bob Haarde shared that P& R commission is having the YMCA come to present and Fairbank members are encouraged to attend; this is a public meeting being held at 6pm on January 13 at the Fairbanks Community Center
- Funding subcommittee acknowledged that this will ultimately need to be formed but it is premature at this time
