REGULATIONS FOR OPEN BURNING

January 15 thru May 1st 2020

MGL Chapter 48, 310 CMR 7.07 and Town of Sudbury bylaw article V section 7 regulate open burning. **Open burning without a permit is subject to a \$25.00 fine.**

The Following Regulations Must Be Followed

- 1. A permit is required for all open burning.
- 2. Burning is only allowed between 10am & 4pm. ALL FIRES MUST BE EXTINGUISHED BY 4pm.
- 3. Under the law you are allowed to burn debris from the following: Domestic tree trimming and pruning, domestic garden preparation, commercial nursery tree trimming and pruning, government nursery and forest tree trimming and pruning and maintenance of existing access ways.
- 4. BURNING MUST BE AT LEAST 75 FEET FROM ALL BUILDINGS.
- 5. Burning must take place on land proximate to the source of material being burned.
- 6. NO HAY, GRASS, LEAVES, PINE NEEDLES, WHOLE TREES, STUMPS, CARPENTRY DEBRIS, BUILDING DEBRIS, PAPER OR RUBBISH MAY BE BURNED AT ANY TIME.
- 7. No land clearing or site clearing for development debris may be burned.
- 8. Burning must be conducted without causing HARDSHIP **OR NUISANCE** to others.
- 9. THE FIRE MUST NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED.
- 10. A means of extinguishing the fire must be available at all times.
- 11. The issuing of a permit does not release the holder from liability for damage caused by this fire.
- 12. The use of any accelerants is strictly prohibited.
