Spring Cleanup: Lyn will contact the Park and Rec Dept to request help with the Hosmer House grounds. It was voted unanimously to have pea stone put in the shed so the sand does not track into the house. Lyn will contact Bill Place to ask for his help on this little project. Lyn will contact Chris Wilson to erect the kiosk at the Training Field next month.

RFP for Restoration: Jim Hill will call Art Smith and Nat Freeman requesting a quote to take down the storeroom ceiling. Once the information has been received Lyn and Jim will go to Maureen to get approval. Mark Kablack has already given approval to approach the restoration in this way. The subcommittee met this month to work on a rough draft of the RFP and Jody will assist with the final copy to go to the Permanent Building Committee for approval and then out to bid.

Florence Hosmer Presentation: Helen Casey will be presenting her research on the Hosmer Family on Sunday, 2 April in the Lower Town Hall. The Historical Society sent the SHC an invitation and all members plan to attend. Lyn and Adolf have been working many hours to help Helen with her research into the private papers of Miss Hosmer. June will contact the Society to see if they will be making a videotape of this and also if it will be on cable. The SHC would like a video so we can show it at the Hosmer Open Houses, held throughout the year. June is to let Jim Hill know so he can make other arrangements if necessary. Win will call Helen to give her some information which the newspapers may want and to let her know she can work at the house on 27 March 06.

24 Pelham Island Barn: Copies of the e-mail sent to the SHC from the Planning Board were passed to all members. This was fully discussed along with information gathered from the tape and minutes of the Hearing, which took place on 8 March and was open to the public for input toward the Demolition Delay By-Law for this property. After considering all aspects of this barn as presented a motion was made to enforce a demolition delay on the barn at 24 Pelham Island Road. The formal vote was 1 for the delay and 5 against. The result is that the Purchase and Sales Agreement can go forward and the contractor who will use the timbers in a barn in Southboro can proceed. Lyn will send an E-mail to notify Jim Kelly and abide with the process put in place for notification. The meeting adjourned at 8:28 PM. The next meeting will be held on 18 April at 7 PM.
