The minutes of October were approved as typed and disseminated. The financial report was given along with deposits and bills to be submitted to the town Accounting Department. It was decided to lower the price on the solid color throws.

A demolition request had been made for property at 781 Boston Post Road. It was determined that it did not come under the Sudbury Demolition By-Law as it was built after 1940 and is not listed in the "Old Homes Survey" books. It also was not found to be historically significant. Lyn will inform Mark Herweck.

Jim Hill reviewed all the proposals that are before CPC for a vote this month. Our request will be reviewed at 8:15 on Wednesday, 17 November in the Flynn Building and commission members are asked to attend. Our submission this year is for multiple projects such as the kioski at the town pound, revolutionary cemetery opening in the stonewall by the Hearst House and a plaque put on the house for 15K. 5K for completing more Old Home Survey documents and 2K for the map of the graves to be replaced on the granite in the Rev. Cemetery.

The Commission unanimously voted to form a subcommittee to study archaeology projects. Jim Hill offered to be the liaison to this subcommittee and Kevin Kennedy will be asked to participate along with three other people that have experience in this field.

Lyn completed the DVD for the docent training which took place on Monday, 17 Nov at the Hosmer House. About 32 docents attended and Liz provided refreshments. Jim will make copies for all members.

Holiday Open House: Nov. 30 the decorators will be at the Hosmer House and Fred will work with Liz and others on that day. The invitations will be sent out on 20 November and Susan Lituwitz is doing the design, making the signage and sending them out. Bill Johnson will put the lights in the windows. Liz and Lyn will install the roping and after the meeting everyone will help put the trees in the rooms. Barbara and Andrea will price the items for sale in the store room on 19 Nov.

Liz and Lyn have been working on North Cemetery and have the maps completed. Liz will give them to Elaine so the bids can go out so repairs can start in the spring. Fred will help identify headstones to the plot plan.
